CONSENT CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

Commissioner of Commerce Steve Kelley (Commissioner) has determined as follows:

1. The Commissioner has advised TMTE, Inc., METALS.COM, CHASE METALS, LLC, and CHASE METALS, INC. (Respondents), that he is prepared to commence formal action pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 45.027 (2018), Chapter 80G, (2018) and other applicable law, based on allegations that Respondents are not registered as a bullion products dealer to solicit, market, buy, or sell, bullion products or investments in bullion products to consumers.
2. Respondents acknowledge that it has been advised of its rights to a hearing in this matter, to present argument to the Commissioner, and to appeal from any adverse determination after a hearing. Respondents hereby expressly waive those rights. Respondents further acknowledge that this order does not address any violations that have occurred and Respondents expressly agree that the purpose of this Order is solely to prevent further violations from occurring. Respondents further acknowledge that it has been represented by legal counsel throughout these proceedings or has waived that right.
3. Respondents have agreed to informal disposition of this matter without a hearing as provided in Minn. Stat. § 14.59 (2018) and Minn. R. 1400.5900 (2017).
4. The following Order is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to Minn. Stat. Ch. 45 (2018), that Respondents shall cease and desist from any further transactions (buying or selling) involving bullion products or investment in bullion products until such time as Respondents have complied with the registration requirements contained in Minnesota Statutes Chapter 80G.

This Order shall be effective upon signature by or on behalf of the Commissioner.



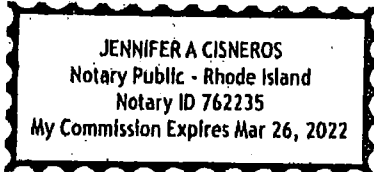


